



- Protect and strengthen Medicaid policy to improve child health.
- Bolster the pediatric health care workforce, including doctors, nurses, and allied health professionals, to ensure the timely delivery of comprehensive and specialized care to children and teens across the country.





Meet #TeamCHA star, Reign!

When Denver was diagnosed with Vein of Galen malformation (VOGM) in utero, her family was desperately looking for answers. Thankfully, a consultation with a Neuro Interventional Radiologist led Denver and her family to Boston Children's Hospital, where they learned about a groundbreaking utero clinical trial designed for her condition. Two weeks later, Denver made history as the first patient in North America to successfully undergo this procedure. Thanks to Denver's care team, she is doing exceptionally well in every category of her neurological assessments! In fact, she has been discharged from speech therapy, physical therapy, and cardiology services. Now, Denver is a happy, sassy two-year-old who continues to defy the odds.

She and her family will be participating in #FAD2025 to advocate for children's health care and bring Denver's story right to lawmakers' desks to share why #MedicaidMatters.




